Lord of Life Families,

As many of you are aware, Lord of Life has had water damage within parts of the building. This damage led us to further investigate potential hazards. We requested a professional air quality/moisture/mold specialist to conduct an analysis which included taking samples in areas of concern. These findings were submitted to LOL this week and raised concerns about potential issues in two KOK classrooms.

The tests in both classrooms revealed low allergenic molds that are within industry standards. Toxic mold was not found within the classrooms. The specialist was not alarmed by the findings, but suggested to err on the side of caution and that it would be prudent to temporarily move the children to another room.

As a precautionary measure, and what we feel is in the best interest of the children, we will be relocating these two classes to other rooms within our building for the remainder of the year. Letters to KOK parents have been sent notifying them of the situation and the actions being taken.

The team listed below along with Michele McGuire, KOK Director, have been working to process the information and make decisions in a timely manner. We are making every effort to remediate this problem as quickly as possible.

Further testing and continued investigation is happening throughout the building and we will keep all informed with up to date information as it becomes available.
